### **Emergency Preparedness and "Ready Go"** (*Attachment*)

At the April, 2025, General Conference, there were a number of messages that focused on the parable of the 10 virgins, and messages that focused on preparation. While our most important preparation is spiritual preparation by developing faith in Jesus Christ and making and keeping covenants, we also want to emphasize the importance of temporal preparation. This can include having some basic, life-sustaining supplies in the event of an emergency. Don and Cathy Brown, our stake emergency preparedness leaders, and the stake presidency would like our stake members to focus on a 4 day "Ready Go" collection of emergency supplies. Even starting with something basic (shoes/clothes in a bag, important documents in one place) is important, and we encourage efforts to make progress. There is an attached list with ideas to help.
