2025 Year-End Results

- Goal: 500,000 names
- Actual: 545,175 names

Breakdown:

- Indexing: 123,700 names/records reviewed
- Quick Name Review: 397,400 names reviewed
- Other Indexing Activities: 24,075

Our 2026 Goals:

1. Have 750 members in the stake either print their own family name cards to take to the temple or submit names to the temple for others to use.
2. Help the youth get more involved in temple and family history work by helping them take their own family names to the temple for baptisms and arranging for each ward's youth group to visit the FamilySearch Center.
